What is Aged Care Watch?

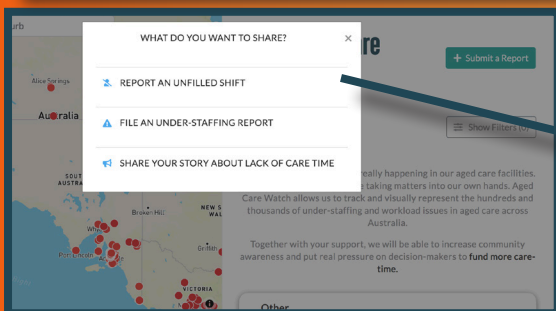
Aged care is in crisis but Scott Morrison has refused to take responsibility. Aged Care Watch is a new crowd-sourced reporting tool allowing aged care workers, residents and family members to **share their experience of the aged care crisis by reporting unfilled shifts, understaffing issues and safety concerns.**

Aged Care Watch will **force** Scott Morrison to sit up, take notice and finally take responsibility.

How does it work?



1. Hit submit report.



2. Choose area of concern.



3. Fill in report.



4. See your report recorded and mapped alongside more than 1,900 other reports.

What do aged care workers say about Aged Care Watch?



"It's time for us all to stand up and support each other."



"We were short staffed four times in one week."

"If it happens and if you have the app, it's easier for you to report, whatever it is."



"A shortage of staff in aged care can give workers a lot of stress."



What do family members say about Aged Care Watch?



"They do need a lot of care, and I'd like to see my husband get more care."
