



HEALTH AND SAFETY CEASE WORK CHECKLIST

If you have a reasonable concern that starting or continuing working will expose you to a serious risk to your safety, emanating from an immediate or imminent exposure to a hazard, then you have a legal right to cease work and demand your boss control the risk.
