Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than 12:00pm** midday Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) **on 22/03/2022**.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au
The subject line of the email should include the reference 'UWU E2021/217 nomination – *your name & electorate*'

In Person: By appointment with the returning officer, at 10 Global Ave Essendon Fields, Melbourne, Victoria 3041

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm midday Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) **on 29/03/2022**.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 19/04/2022 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 17/05/2022.

The appointment of scrutineers closes 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 17/05/2022.
