When is this year's conference?

Lighting the Way (LTW) will be held Saturday 14 October 2023. The conference will commence at 8.30am, with the last session finishing at 4.45pm. All guests are invited to attend the LTW afterparty from 5pm in the Boulevard room of the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre, where light nibbles and drinks will be served, and a DJ will keep guests entertained! Please note, for catering purposes there will be a separate rsvp when you register for this event, there is no additional cost.

Where is the venue?

The conference will be held at the <u>Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre</u>, (<u>BCEC</u>) corner Merivale and Glenelg Streets South Brisbane. Centrally located, the BCEC provides the perfect space for guests to spread out and enjoy a special day together.

**3** When can I get tickets, and how much will it cost to attend?

Registration will be available to United Workers Union members from 9am Thursday 17 August 2023. Members will be emailed a booking link prior to opening. Tickets for members cost **\$55**. Tickets for UWU non-members cost **\$80**, and students cost **\$25**.

Does my school cover the cost of my attending (flights, accommodation, and registration)?

LTW is an opportunity for Teacher Aide professional development, and covering the cost of attending is at the discretion of each school's Principal. Have a discussion with your Principal about LTW, and if there is an opportunity for costs to be covered by your school's budget. For regional Teacher Aides the department has a travel assistance fund, please talk to your Principal about accessing that fund. Your Union knows how valuable professional development is for Teacher Aides, and supports schools providing professional development for Teacher Aides through conferences such as LTW.

#### Can you invoice my school for the registration cost, or do we have to pay with a card?

No, we will not be able to invoice schools individually, but BM's, Admin or Principals will be able to pay directly via the LTW registration page and they can pay for more than one person at a time, so multiple TA's can enrol at once. Just ensure that the BM has the details of which workshop sessions you would like to attend at time of registration. Schools can pay with a corporate card though as school leadership should have a corporate card that they can pay with. That would save attendees having to pay yourself and then doing a reimbursement request.
